

SEVEN PRINCIPLES OF LEADERSHIP

Principle 1 Lead by example, and not by command. **1 Pet 5:2-3** 1 Thess 5:12 Heb 13:7,17
1 Tim 5:17 1 Tim 3:4,12

Explain about the word “**rule**” in the N.T. (Greek): “Have the leading of you”
Explain about the word “**obey**” in the N.T. (Greek): “Allow yourselves to be persuaded by”

Principle 2 Multiply yourselves through discipleship. Be a spiritual father to others.
1 Cor 4:15-17 2 Tim 2:2

Principle 3 Release trained disciples into **their** vision, network with them and pray for them.
2 Tim 4:5 1 Tim 4:14

Principle 4 You serve the Lord first, and not people. Your orders come from Him. Learn to hear His voice.
1 Cor 7:23 Jn 10:27

Principle 5 Learn faithfulness by serving another man’s vision for a time. **Lk 16:12**

Principle 6 Do the important things, not the urgent things. Here is the order of importance:
1. God (personal time)
2. Spouse
3. Children
4. Secular job
5. Ministry
Decide what is important and focus on it. Avoid distractions. Don’t take on too much.

Principle 7 Bring the spirit of excellence into everything you do. You are in training to rule with Christ in the Millennium.
