It has been a long time since you heard from me and Remote Area Ministries. Praise God, I am doing well and have help from my daughter Amy and other gifted friends who help with this newsletter. Amy and husband Doug are now on the board of directors and help me remain a 501c3 organization, carrying out the vision Jack and I started 35 years ago. By God's grace I have been able to follow up on a few contacts he made in India and Papua New Guinea and want to give glory to God in what is happening currently. Yes, I miss Jack, but my focus is still on other nations.

First, I want to thank those of you who have sent donations, so I was able to send gifts to India, the leader whom Jack met and travelled with years ago: Dr. Valerian Albuquerque. He recently was invited to speak at conferences in Kenya, Uganda and Tanzania, Africa. Many churches had already started and he was able to give them more teaching materials including the Gill Manuals which we have used extensively. He wrote that "Many were touched by God and were envisioned to carry on the vision of making disciples throughout their nations. There were many signs and wonders..."



Then he went to northeast India, where he was able to introduce Kingdom Training Centers using the same Gill manuals. He then commission **sixty pastors** with authority to perform the sacraments, marriages, funerals and register for legal documents. He wrote about persecutions too. **We praise God that there is such hunger in India!**

Papua New Guinea

Jack met Pastor Tom Koim and His wife years ago. Pastor Tom now ministers in a few churches in Port Moresby, the capital. RAM sent him the Wordless Gospel book for the tribals but what he loved most was a prayer book written by Pastor Joe Sweet www.Shekinahworship.com. He received 100 of the prayer books, distributed them among other church leaders and said the government declared a day of Repentance. Then later they held a 3 day prayer conference and encouraged all church members to have one hour of prayer every day. He dearly wants more prayer manuals which he can download free from Shekinah Worship, but it costs a bit to print it in New Guinea.



The Lord has been so good to our nation in spite of all our failings. The battle for truth is still our agenda and faith that the gospel will change hearts. My present goal is to abide in Him and be changed into His image. I am learning to be still and wait on Him for each activity. He is SO compassionate and kind! Please pray especially for the unreached tribals in Papua New Guinea.
